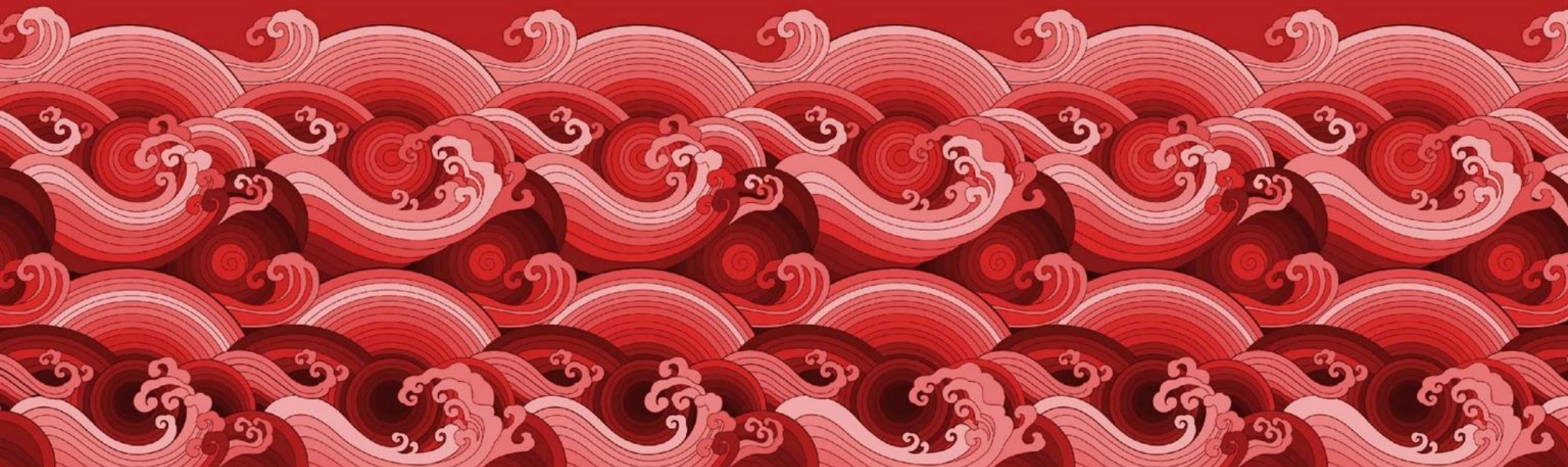




JCCI EKIDEN 2024

RACEKIT RECEIVING INSTRUCTION

The organizer will issue racekit for all teams who participate on 23 and 24 November, 2024.

First Date: 23/11/2024: Place of receiving Racekit: Expo area, The Garden Bistro from 8h30 – 18h30.

Second date: 24/11/2024: Place of receiving racekit: Bib issue area of organizer, Expo area from 6h00 – 6h30.

Racekit receiving procedure


- **CHECK IN**

Athlete will come to Racekit area and present some below information:


 - Qr code which send to team leader or team representative
 - Passport (copy or scan) with foreigner, ID for Vietnamese

- **BIB RECEIVING**

Valid information, athletes receive bib and racekit

- **T-SHIRT RECEIVING**

Athletes check size, quantity according to registered .

- **CHECK BIB – COMPLETE**

Athletes will move to check BIB area to check the signal and complete the procedure.


Note: - Athletes check again BIB number and racekit before leaving organizer's booth.

- Athletes is responsible for their BIB number, the organizers will not take responsibility and re-issue BIB number
- Qr code has been sent to team leader (representative), please check email/trash/spam and contact with information desk of organizers if not receive.

PRIZE STRUCTURE

PRIZE STRUCTURE

Prizes are divided into two prize systems: **JCCI PRIZE, EXTENSION PRIZE, INDIVIDUAL PRIZE .**

1. JCCI Prize

JCCI prize applies only for organizers, Companies, businesses that are members of JCCI.

2. EXTENSION PRIZE:

Extension prize is the prize for organizers, companies, businesses that are not member of JCCI. In case organizers, Companies, businesses register professional athletes to participate, it is MANDATORY to NOTIFY the organizer

3. INDIVIDUAL PRIZE – APPLIED FOR JCCI MEMBER

The Individual Prize is for the best male and female athlete based on recorded performance times from the organizer system. This system applies only to amateur athletes; no individual prize are given to professional athletes.

In cases where professional athletes intentionally fail to declare their status, if verified by organizer, they will be disqualified from receiving the prize, and the prize will be reassigned to eligible amateur athletes.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Competition Format:

The event is organized in a relay race format – EKIDEN, with each team consisting of 5 members. Each member must complete a distance of 3.5km as specified by the organizer. Each team is required to have at least one female member, who must run at the third leg. The race is considered valid only when the previous runner finishes and hands over the TASUKI sash within the designated area to the next runner. Handing over the sash outside the designated area, either before or after, will be considered a violation and the team's result will not be recognized.

Number of participating teams:

It is expected that 200 teams will participate, with a total of 1000 athletes.

The TASUKI sash is equipped with a chip by the organizer

GENERAL REGULATION

1. Each running leg is only one athlete from each team.
2. Athletes must wear a bib number on the front of their chest for easy identification.
3. Athletes must use the "Tasuki" sash provided and prepared by the organizer, worn diagonally across the body (as illustrated). The Tasuki sash will be equipped with an electronic chip by organizer to record timing, therefore athletes must not fold or alter the sash during the race.
4. Athletes must run in the designated leg as registered with organizer, and the assigned leg number will be printed on each athlete's bib.
5. If any athlete from a team violates any of the following rules, the entire team will be disqualified and their performance will not be recognized (except in emergency situations):
 - ✓ Intentionally running outside the designated course or taking shortcuts.
 - ✓ Using skates or any other means of transportation during the race.
 - ✓ Deliberately obstructing or interfering with the path of another team member.
 - ✓ Engaging in acts that undermine the fairness of the competition, pose dangers, spread false information about the event, or violate the law.
 - ✓ Arriving late after the start time of the first leg.
 - ✓ Not being present in the designated Tasuki handover area at the time of their leg.
 - ✓ Wearing attire that does not respect local customs and traditions at any point during the event.
 - ✓ Misplacing or damaging the Tasuki sash, handing over the Tasuki outside the designated area, or wearing the Tasuki incorrectly (folded, carried by hand, etc.).
 - ✓ Not wearing or improperly wearing the bib during the race

TERMS AND REGULATIONS

These terms and regulations are an integral part of the Registration Form and Liability Waiver.

1.1. We understand that running is a potentially risky activity for personal health if not adequately prepared and trained prior to participating in the Event. We declare that we have trained sufficiently for this event and do not perceive any signs of illness, injury, or physical discomfort that could cause harm or death to us while participating in the Event

1.2. We acknowledge the physical demands of the Event and anticipate that if we have a history of cardiovascular, renal, joint, etc., diseases, participating in the Event may pose health risks to us. In the event we become aware of any personal health issues, illness, or injury before or during the Event, we will immediately withdraw from the Event.

1.3. We agree to fully comply with all decisions of the organizer regarding our health status and ability to safely complete the Event

1.4. We fully understand, anticipate, and accept all risks associated with the Event, including but not limited to minor injuries, serious injuries, slip-and-fall injuries, collisions with others, effects of weather, traffic, conditions of the running course, and death.

1.5. We fully understand that any risks to us during participation in the Event are beyond the desire and control of the organizer. We undertake to take responsibility for all the aforementioned risks and do not demand compensation or legal liability against the organizer, any member of organizer, volunteers, sponsors, VietJungle Co., Ltd., JCCI for any risks incurred to us during participation in the Event.

TERMS AND REGULATIONS

1.6. We agree that if we require medical assistance, the organizer will make every reasonable effort to arrange medical aid and emergency transportation for us if deemed necessary by the organizer; and we assume responsibility for all related expenses

1.7. We, ourselves or anyone acting on our behalf, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organizer, any member thereof, volunteers, sponsors, authorities, and employees from any wrongful acts, damages, losses, costs, claims, demands for compensation, rights of action, or disputes of any kind, arising out of any injury, loss, damage, or death occurring to us or our property while participating in the Event.

1.8. We agree with organizer's filming, photographing, broadcasting, or otherwise documenting us and our activities during the Event, without charge or compensation. We agree that any images, videos, or multimedia data depicting us are the intellectual property created and owned by the organizer, and the organizer retains full discretion within the limits permitted by law

1.9. We agree to allow organizer to use our name, provided personal information, and event results for organizational purposes

1.10. We agree to comply with all terms and regulations of the Event and with instructions given by the organizer, its members, and volunteers at all times.

TERMS AND REGULATIONS

1.11. We agree that the organizer may change the running course map from the advertised route without prior notice if deemed necessary. We also understand and agree that the organizer may cancel the event without prior notice due to force majeure conditions related to weather, political activities, terrorism, and similar events. In such cases, we agree and accept that our event participation fees may not be refunded.

1.12 We commit that the race bib number assigned to us (also known as bib) will only be used by the Runner with the information provided at the beginning of this Registration Form. If the bid number is unauthorized use, we accept that organizer has the full right to invalidate results and reject any related complaints. We also understand and accept that the organizer has no obligation or liability towards unauthorized runners. In the event of unauthorized use of the bib number, we will bear full responsibility for any consequences caused to individuals or organizations associated with the event.

1.13. We commit to complying with any requests to stop the race from organizer during the event and waive all liabilities towards the organizer if we fail to comply with these requests

1.14. We have read, understood, and agree to all the Terms of Participation set forth by organizer.

1.15. By signing this document or confirming via email that we have read, understood, and agree to this document, we confirm our full agreement with the terms and regulations of the JCCI EKIDEN 2024 race..
